What is biodiesel?

Biodiesel is an alternative fuel produced from domestic, renewable resources, which can be used in unmodified diesel engines with the current fueling infrastructure. Biodiesel contains no petroleum, but it can be blended at any level with petroleum diesel to create a biodiesel blend. It can be used in compression-ignition (diesel) engines without modifications. Its physical and chemical properties, as it relates to operation of diesel engines, are similar to petroleum-based diesel fuel.
